#### PRELIMINARY REHEARSAL INFORMATION

The Theater cannot inform me of their theater drama department schedule until March, 2023 at which time I will set our times for the Rehearsals.

## **SHOW**

The show is located at the Smithwick Theater at Foothill College. We rent the theater for two days for our rehearsal and show day. I feel the show is very important for the students. It builds their confidence in performing in front of an audience. They have the experience of being on a stage and to be a member of a group. Our students have a fun time rehearsing on the stage in their costumes and spending the day with their class and Instructors. I must say the staff and I enjoy the two days!!! The show fee is \$50.00 per student and the tickets \$22.00 per person. The deposit allows us to keep the cost of the tickets low at \$22.00. Some studios have a show deposit and still charge 35 to 40 dollars a ticket.

## **COSTUME INFORMATION**

I do not know currently the exact price of the show costumes, since I do not receive the costume catalogs until November. I assume like everything else the prices will be higher this year. The table below is the costume price per class. I do try keep the cost of the costumes as low as possible. These prices do not include shipping and sales tax.

No costume will be ordered without a deposit. The remaining balance for your costumes will be due February 1st. Please do not include the costume payments with tuition. Your deposit will be refunded if your child drops the class before December 15<sup>th</sup>.
