Shows are scheduled for June 8, 2024.

We at Marti's Dance Studio believe that the annual Dance Show is a very fulfilling experience for the students. Not only does it give them the opportunity to perform for their family and friends, but it also reaffirms important life skills such as personal responsibility and cooperating with a group.

We understand that some students may have other obligations or may not choose to participate, and so we keep the costs associated with the show separate from tuition fees.

There is a \$50.00 per student show fee that is due by April 1, 2024. The show deposit will allow us to charge less for tickets on the day of the show. The Show will be at the Spangenberg Theater at Gunn High School on Saturday June 8^{th} .

Dance Show Rehearsals

Rehearsals will be scheduled on June 7 and June 6

Rehearsal attendance: All students performing in the show must attend the rehearsals. Scheduled family vacations, family emergencies and work schedule conflicts, are activities that will excuse students from rehearsals. Camps will not be excused.

More information later in the year. The times for the three shows will be announced later in the year.

On the First of May you will receive a notice that will contain information for the Picture Day, Rehearsal Day, and the show your child will perform in. I suggest you post this notice in your child's room so that you can follow the times and days.

Dance Apparel

All students must always wear the proper shoes for classes. All jazz shoes must be a tan color. You can wait until after the first class when the instructors will announce the style of shoes for the class.

Dancers in all **Jazz, Lyrical/Contemporary, Technic, and Ballet classes** must wear proper clothing to allow the teacher to observe each student's technique. Leotards, ballet dresses, or a form-fitting top with a ballet skirt or jazz pants are appropriate. Acro classes must wear one piece outfit or a leotard, with shorts or leggings. No T-shirts for Acro classes.

Tap, Hip Hop, and all other classes have a different dress code, the teachers will discuss this dress code at the first lesson of each class.

The dress codes must be followed.

For the safety of the students no, student can dance with their hair down. No dresses or jeans for class.

All students must make sure their hair is pulled back from their face and secured tightly in a ponytail. Short hair can wear head bands.

Costumes.

We do our best throughout the first part of the season to locate new and exciting costumes for our dancers to wear in the 2024 show. Costumes for the Annual Show are <u>not included</u> in tuition fees and are billed separately.

We will not know the exact costume prices until later this year. The costume prices are approximately \$80.00 for Tiny Toes, \$85.00 for young students, and \$95.00 for older students. Sales tax & shipping costs are not included. I have always been cost conscience in purchasing our costumes. Regarding Hip Hop classes we try to purchase items that can be used after the show. I place the orders by December 15, 2023.

I cannot order a costume if the deposit has not been paid.

Our October notice will have all the show and costume information.

Registration Fee

Please submit the registration fee of \$45.00 per student with your registration form.

Annual Tuition

We added ½ month class session in August. See note below. Annual tuition fees are based on classes meeting weekly for 10½ months, excluding school holidays. Tuition is discounted based on the total number of classes taken by all the students in a family.

Tuition is payable monthly. You may pay in advance for the whole year, or every six months, or every two months.

Late Fees

A student cannot continue classes if tuition is past due over 30 days. All Monthly payments must be paid by the 15th of each month, or a \$10.00 late fee will be added to your account.

We do not change the tuition on the number of classes per month. Tuition is the same from Sept. through June. Some months have more than 4 lessons in a month.
